



Slips, Trips and Falls are PREVENTABLE

F LOORS

Survey all work area floors at the start of your shift to make sure all walking surfaces are clean and dry.

L OGS

Always log inspections no matter how often they are performed.

O UTSIDE

Check for obvious trip and fall hazards such as potholes, damaged car stops, exposed rebar, heaving pavement, and cracks in walking areas or steps that could present a hazard to your customers.

O N TIME

Don't delay! Cleaning spills immediately will help avoid accidents. Always finish with a Dry Mop, which helps eliminate the wet floor hazard.

R ESTROOMS

Check restrooms frequently to clean up debris and mop if needed. Check every 15 minutes during the busiest hours. Make sure to log every check and action taken.

S EE

If you see a spill, stand at the hazardous location and signal for assistance. Leaving the spill unattended for even a short time may result in someone slipping on it.
