

Sample Severe Weather Checklist: Heavy Wind, Rain and Hail

Extreme weather and severe thunderstorms producing high winds, heavy rain, hail and even tornadoes — or a combination of these conditions — can occur with little or no warning. That's why it's important to be able to act quickly if a severe weather system approaches your area. The following checklist can help you protect property when a fast response is needed. The checklist should be customized based on your building and occupancy.
